Spike - Motion & Second PASSED to disband the Spike club at the State level.

- ✓ Spike will be recognized at every Board Meeting.
- ✓ Chair has asked for 1 Spike member from each HBA to use as the Spike committee to plan activities. All HBAs provided her with a name
- Membership IBCA is at a 72% retention rate & 1131 members
 - ✓ Hopes that Association Health Plan will help.
 - ✓ Dave Ashby (NAHB) shared that IBCA is close to the national retention rate.
- Associates Round table discussion on associates and their purpose. It was discussed the need to combine event efforts with other committees like membership to engage members and associates. Some ideas are Builder panels having committee meetings at member businesses giving them 10 mins to talk about whatever they wanted.

- A Motion & Second PASSED to have Ken Burgess draft up a letter in support of these changes to Dept of Occupational Licenses D.O.P.L.
 - ✓ Ken will send out the red line edits.

H389 – The 8 % Budget cap to limit growth. Ken needs to gather data on increases & new impact fees to submit along with a letter to the Governor, that this 8% budget cap is strangling our Industry. Ken has asked for this data from Locals.

- Residential Values are growing higher than commercial.
- City Area-Impact Annexation- IBCA has been invited by Senator Lakey in the discussion of working through this, asking for volunteer Developers around different parts of state to help with this.



- School Impact Fees City of Kuna having a hard time getting this going.
- Impact Advisory Committee (Have to live in the area to be on Committee) Ken Burgess's currently working with Anne Westcott on writing something up in hopes to find a solution, as this has caused a lot of problems for small jurisdictions
